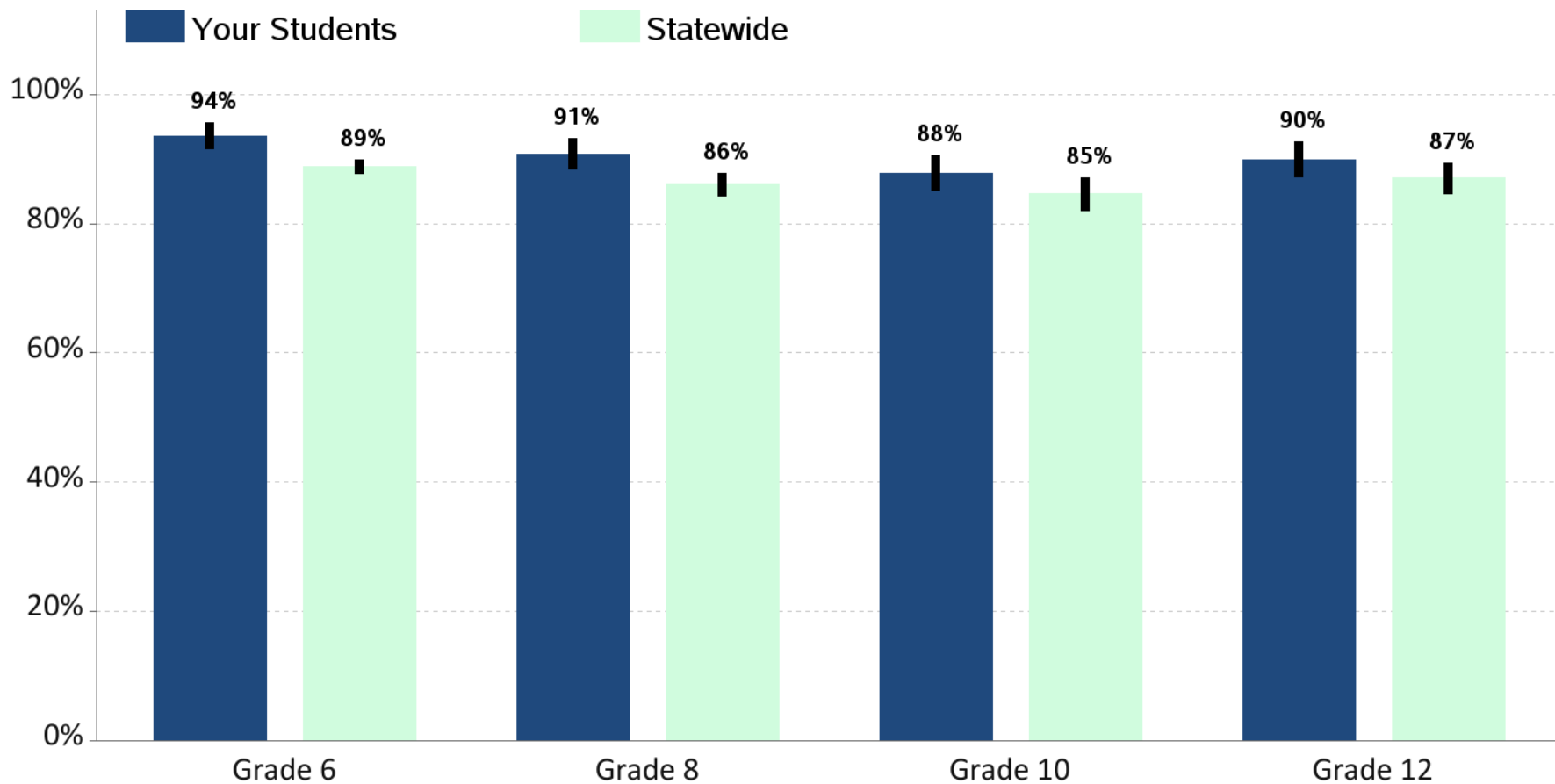

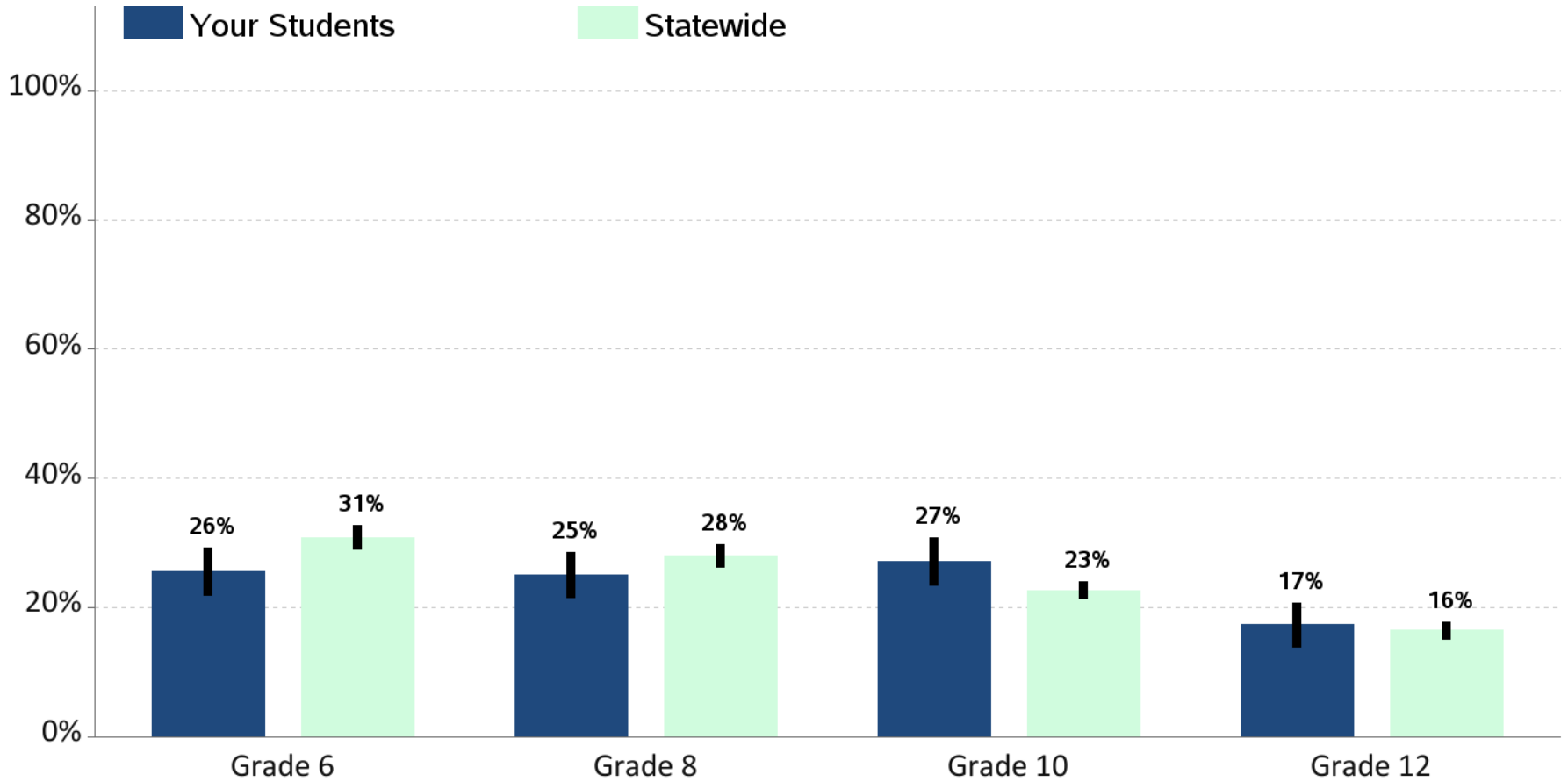
Feeling Safe at School

Percent of students who report that they feel safe at school

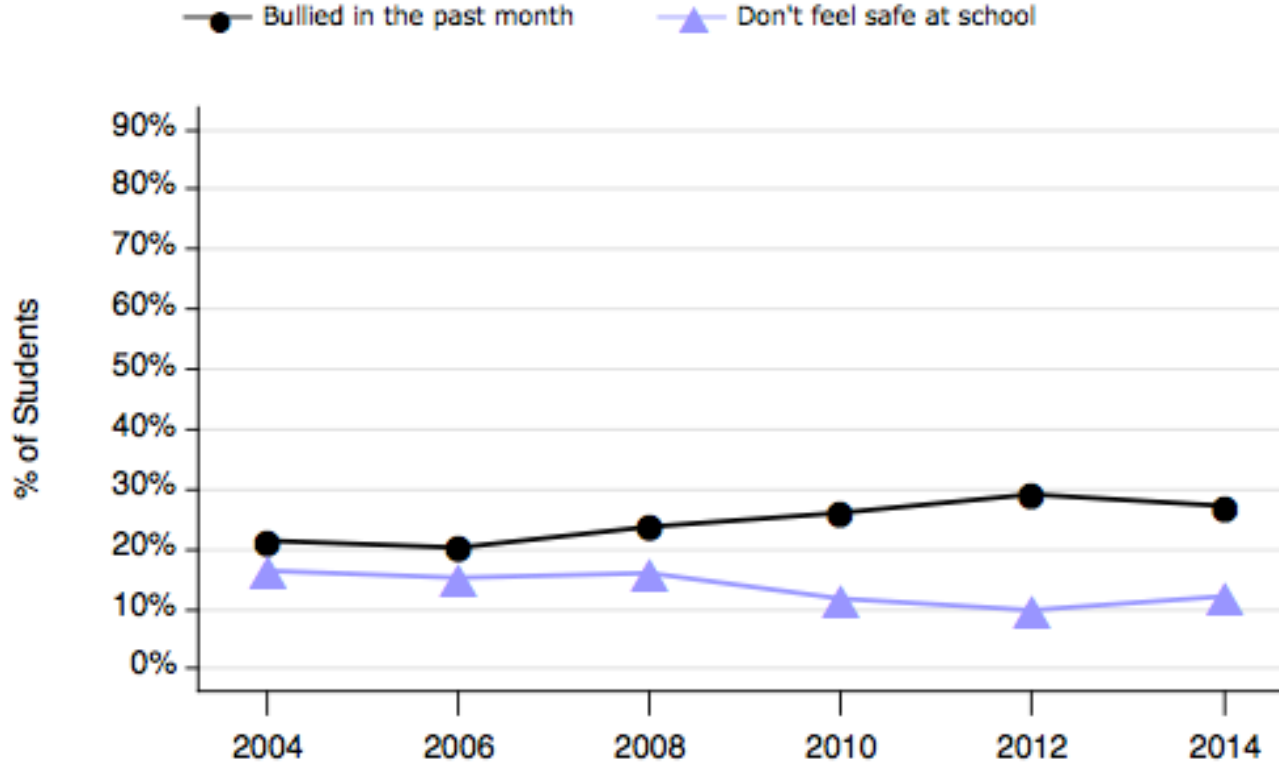


Bullying

in the past 30 days

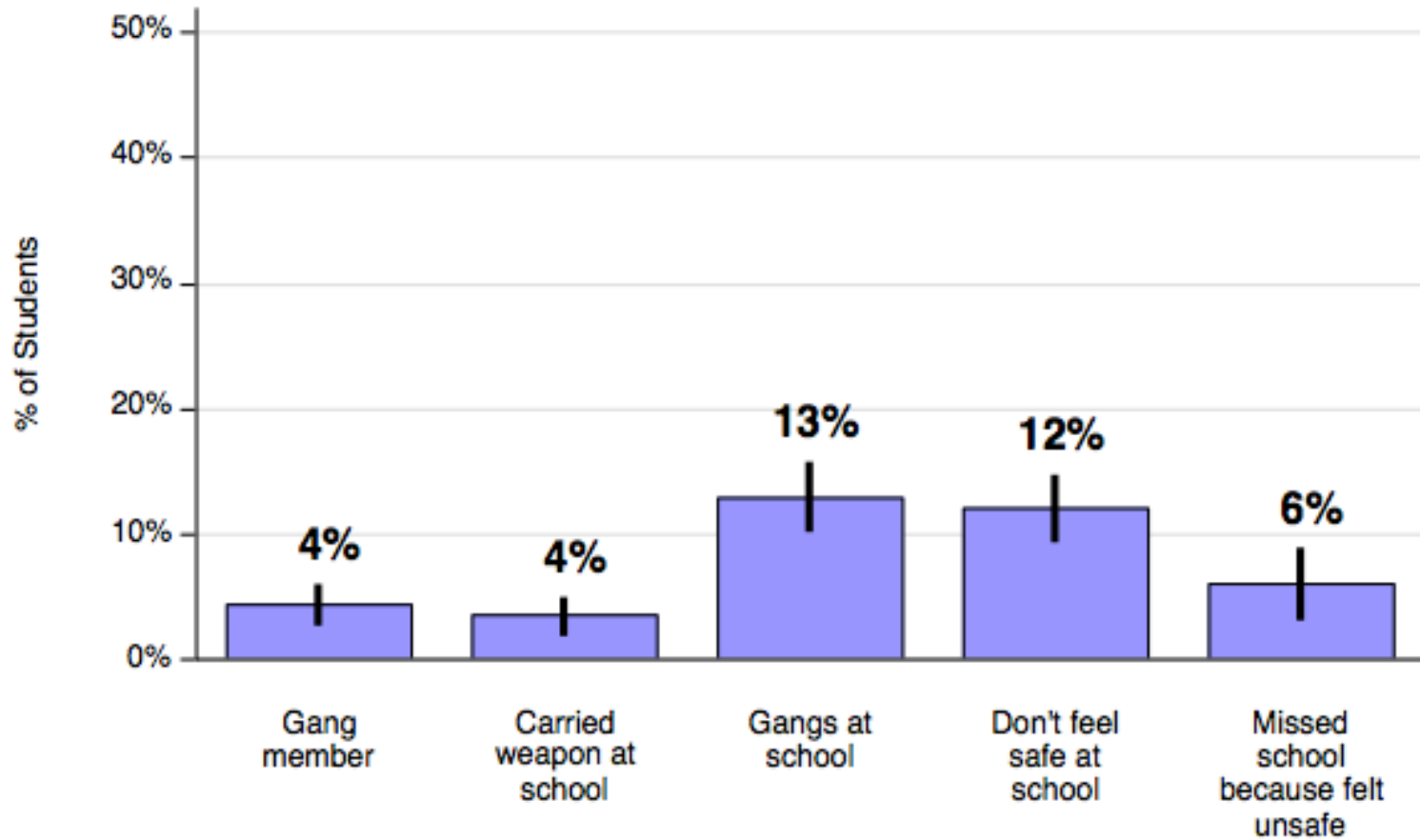

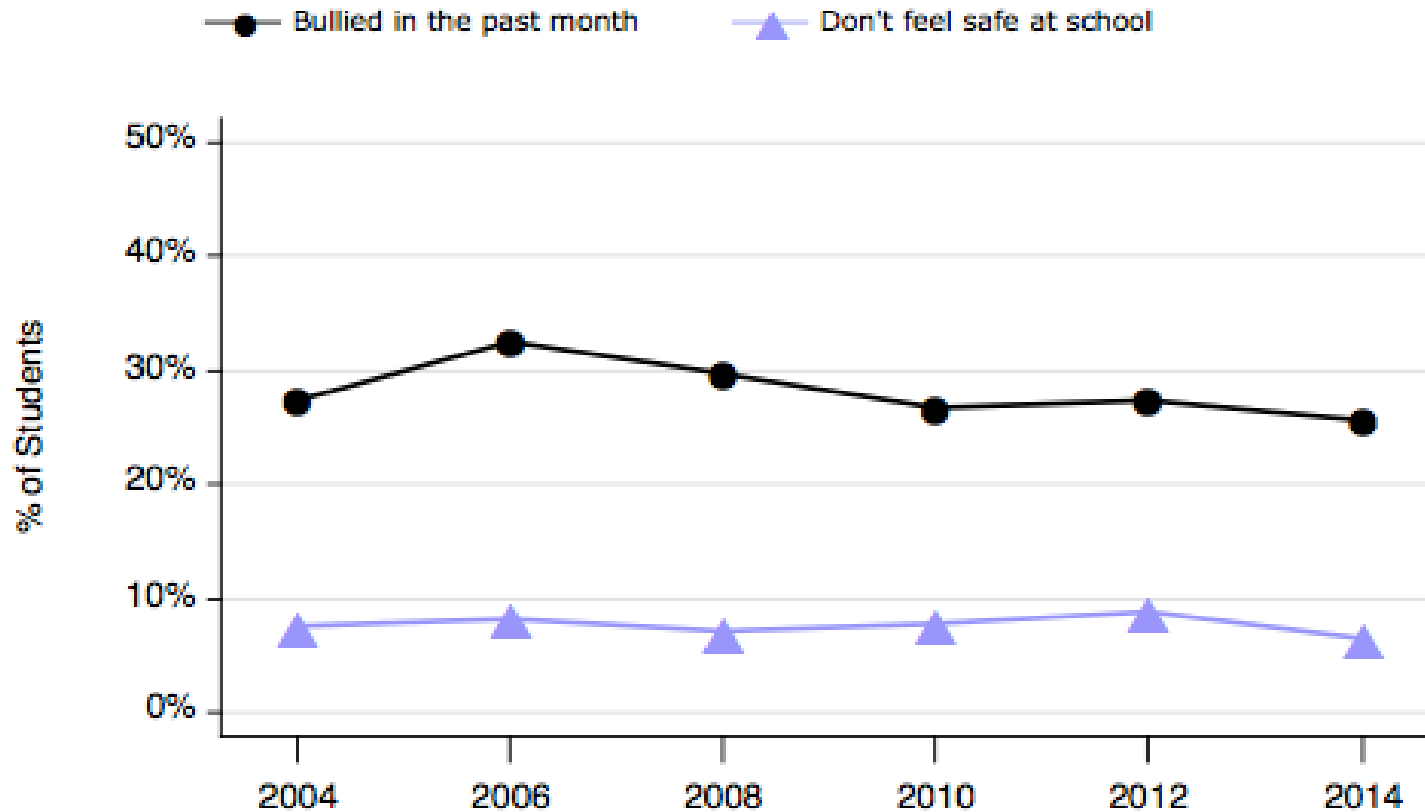

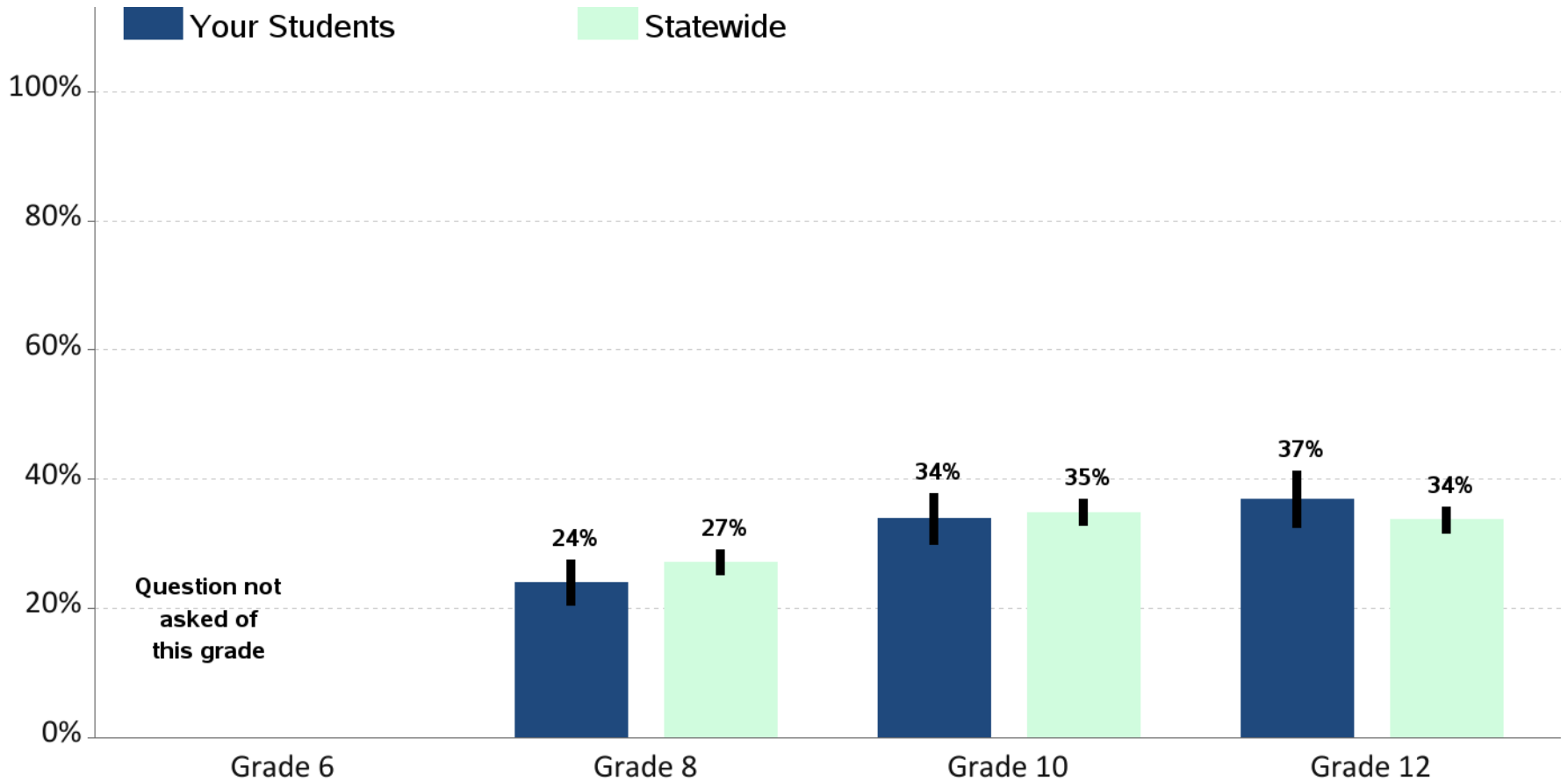

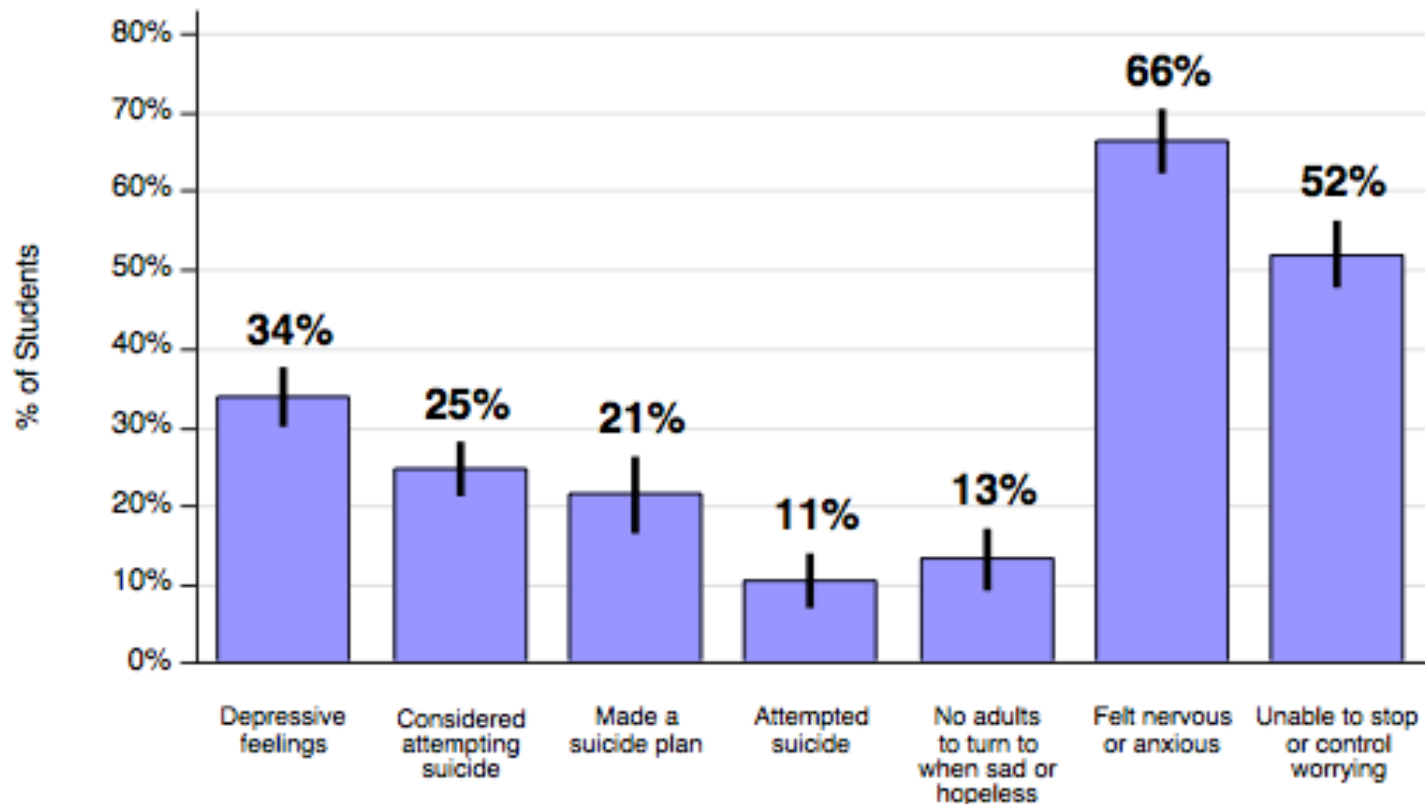
Depression and Suicide

in the past year

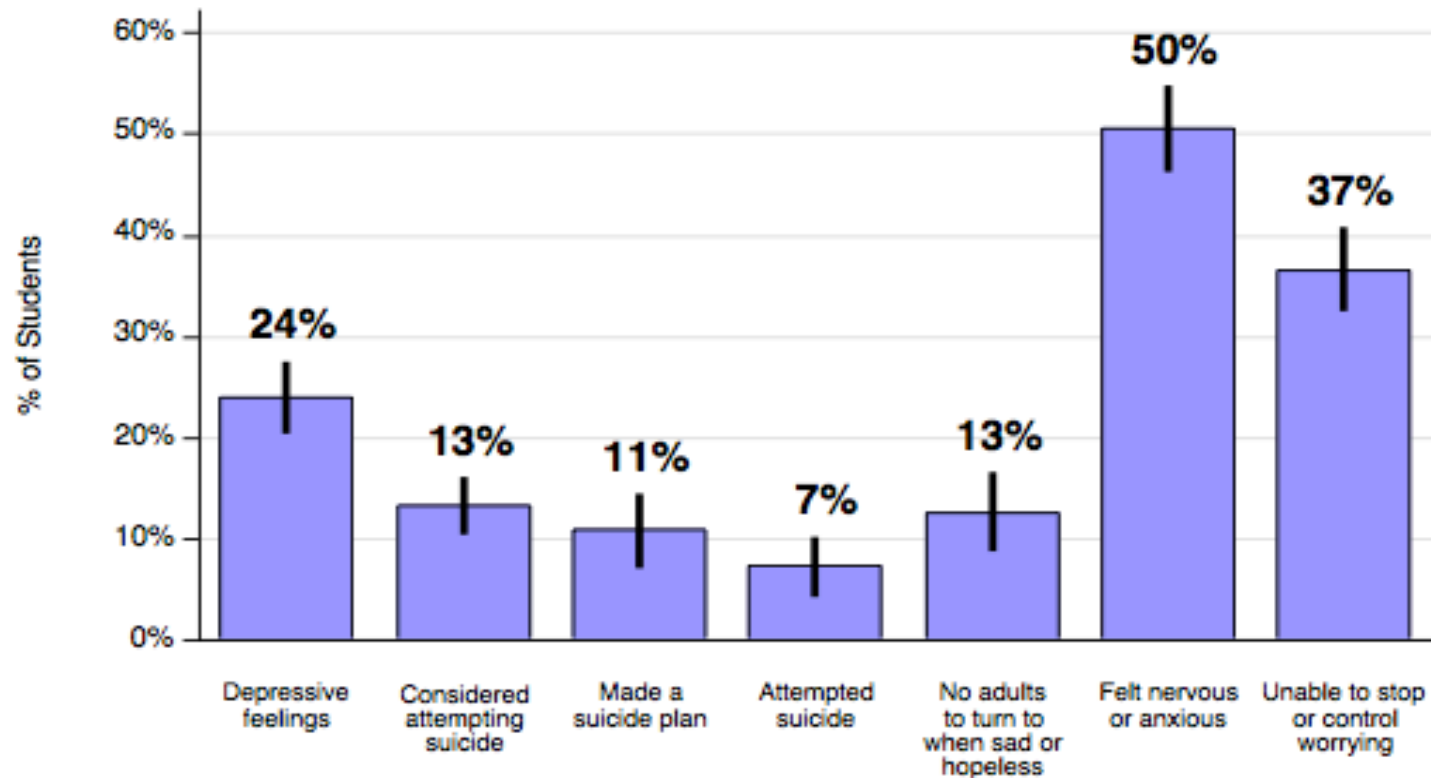


Depressive Feelings and Suicide Grade 10, 2014



In 2014, 34% of 10th graders in our school district felt so sad or hopeless for 2 weeks or more that they stopped doing their usual activities.

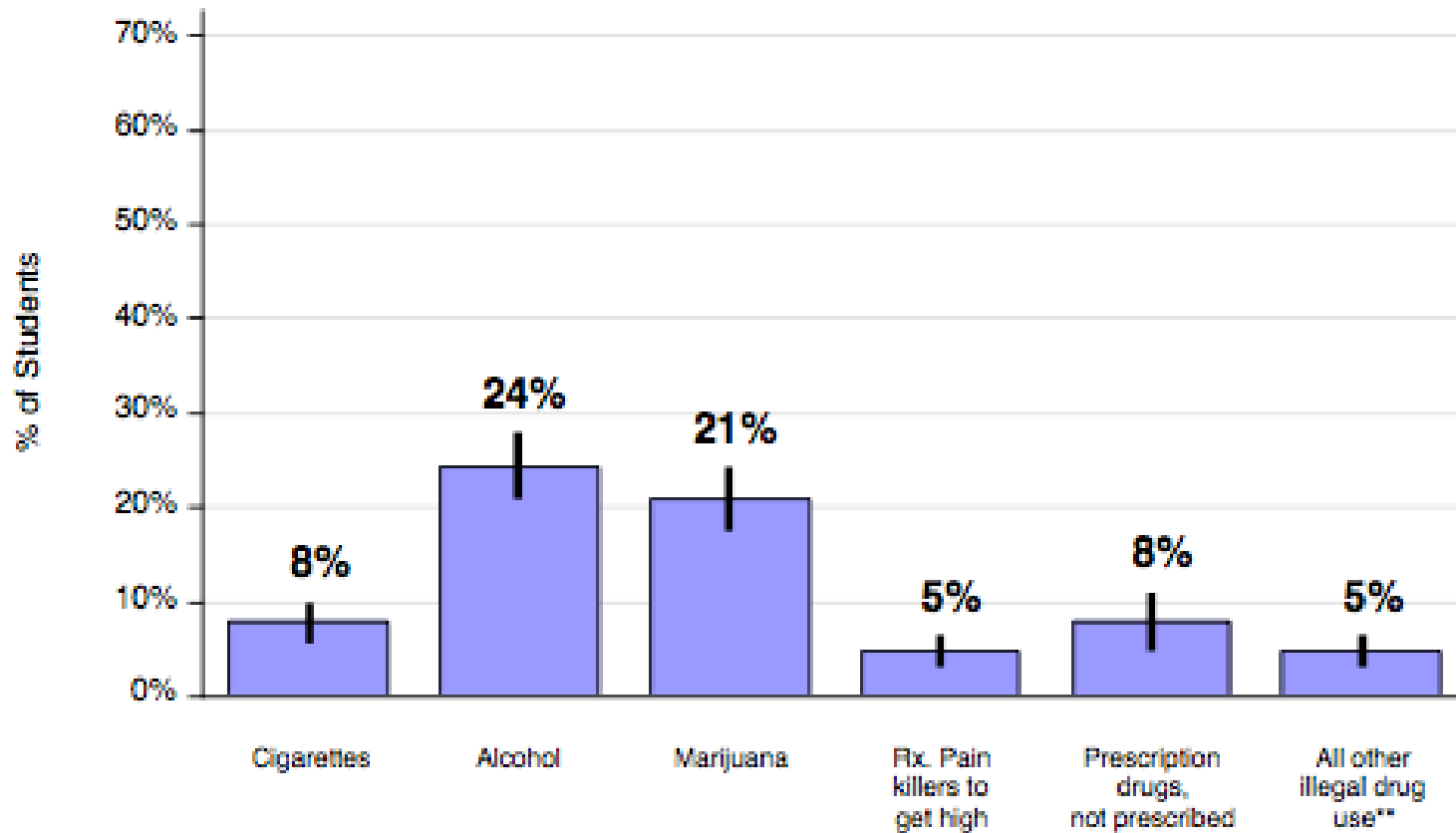
Depressive Feelings and Suicide Grade 8, 2014

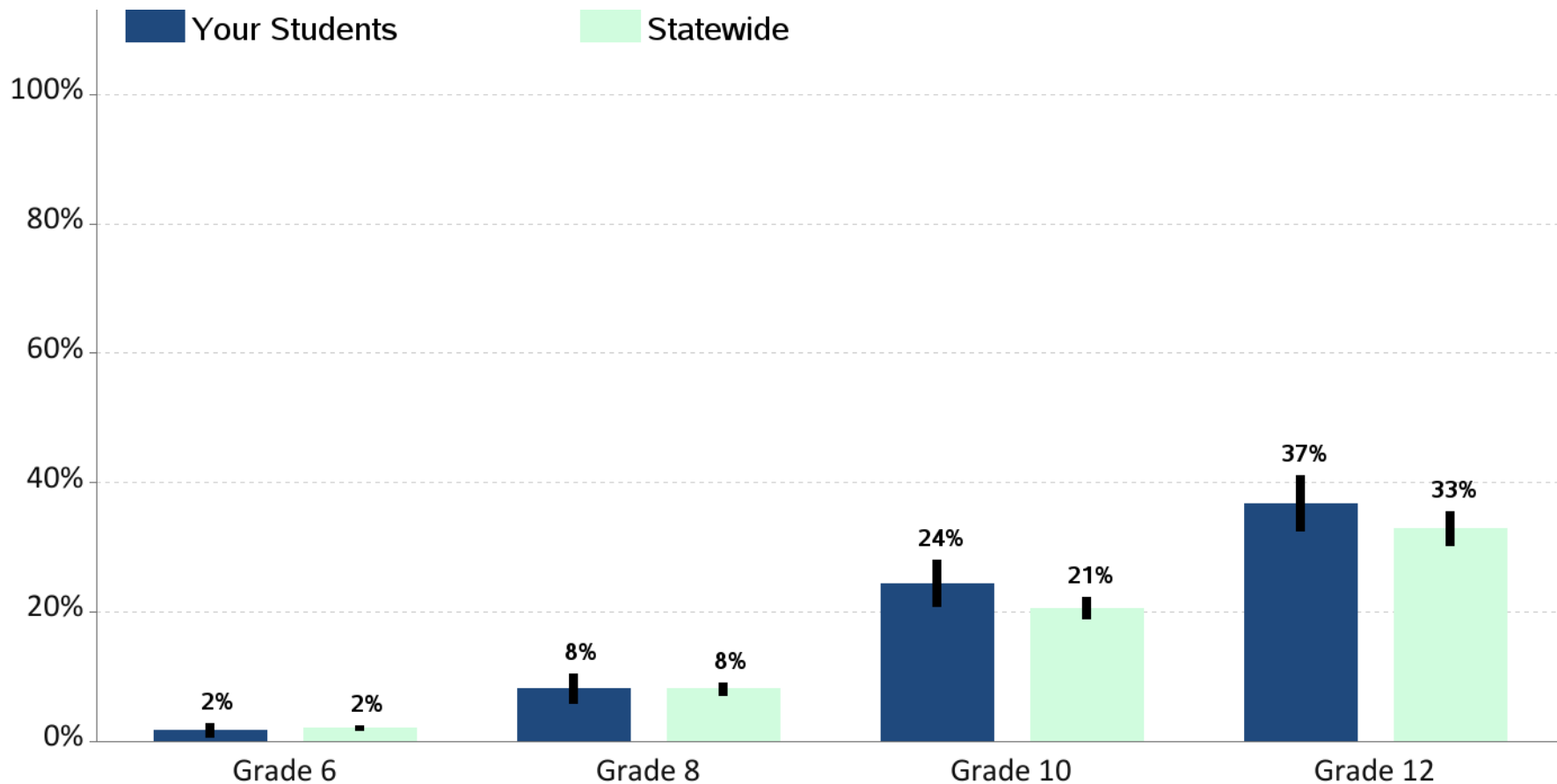
Current (past 30-day) Substance Use Grade 10, 2014



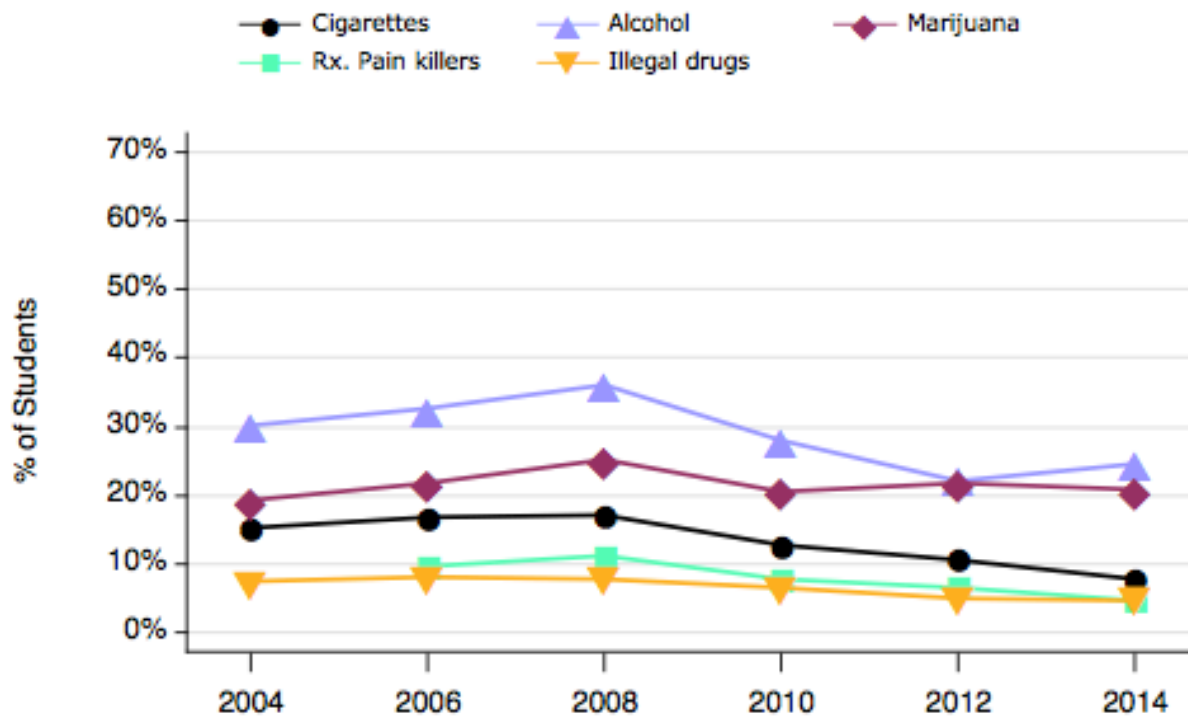

Percent of students who report having drunk a glass, can or bottle of alcohol in the past 30 days

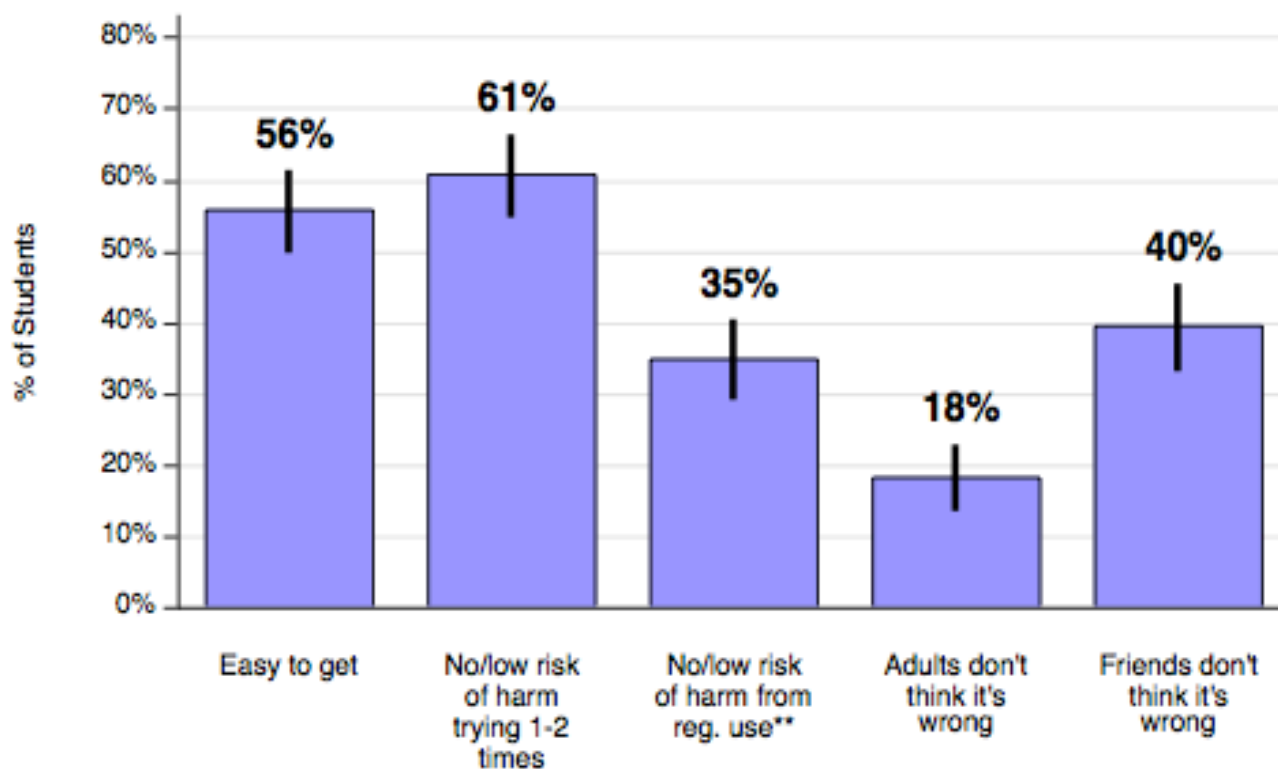

Attitudes about Marijuana Use Grade 10, 2014

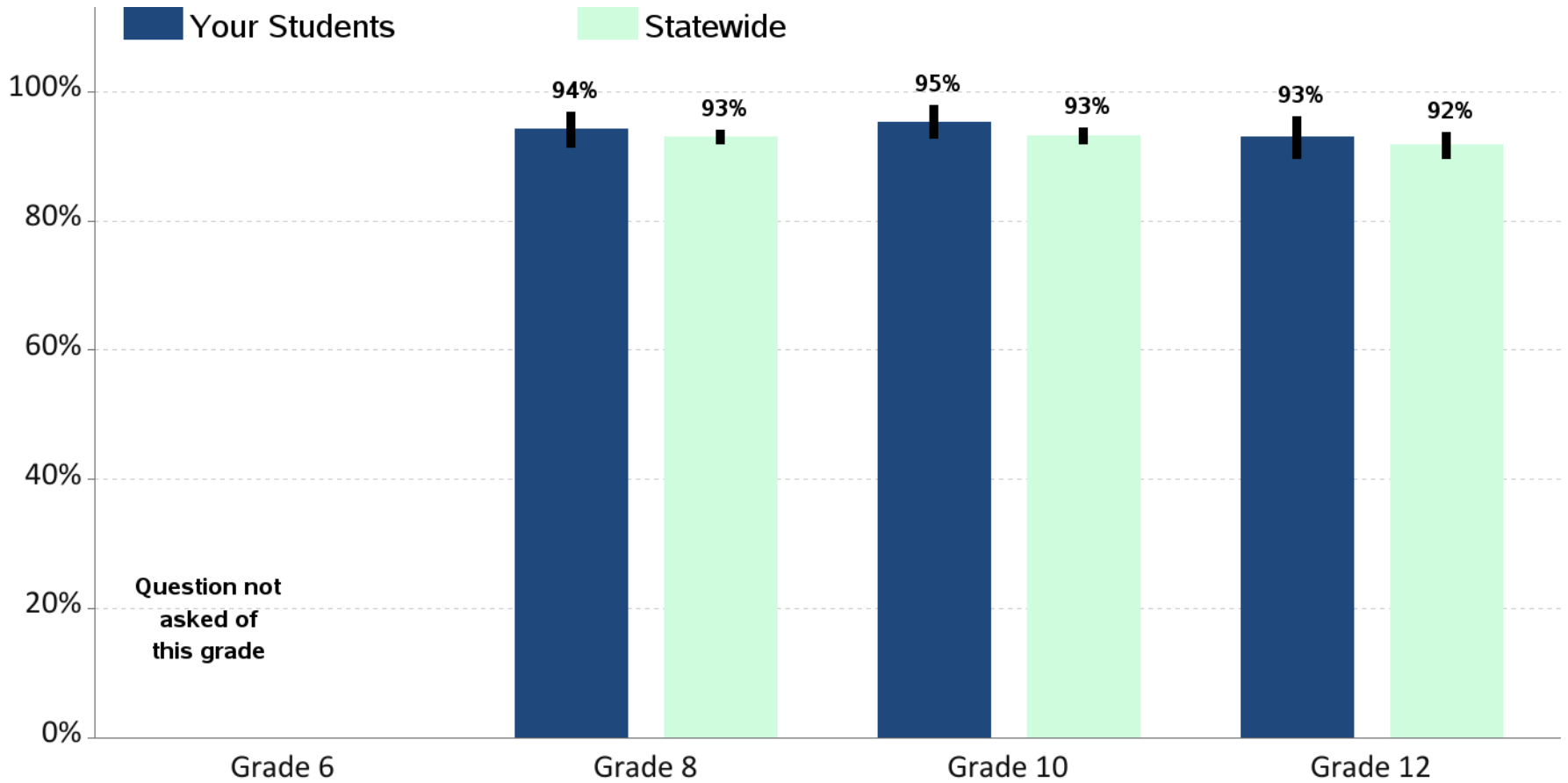


In 2014, 35% of 10th graders in our school district thought there was little or no risk of using marijuana regularly.

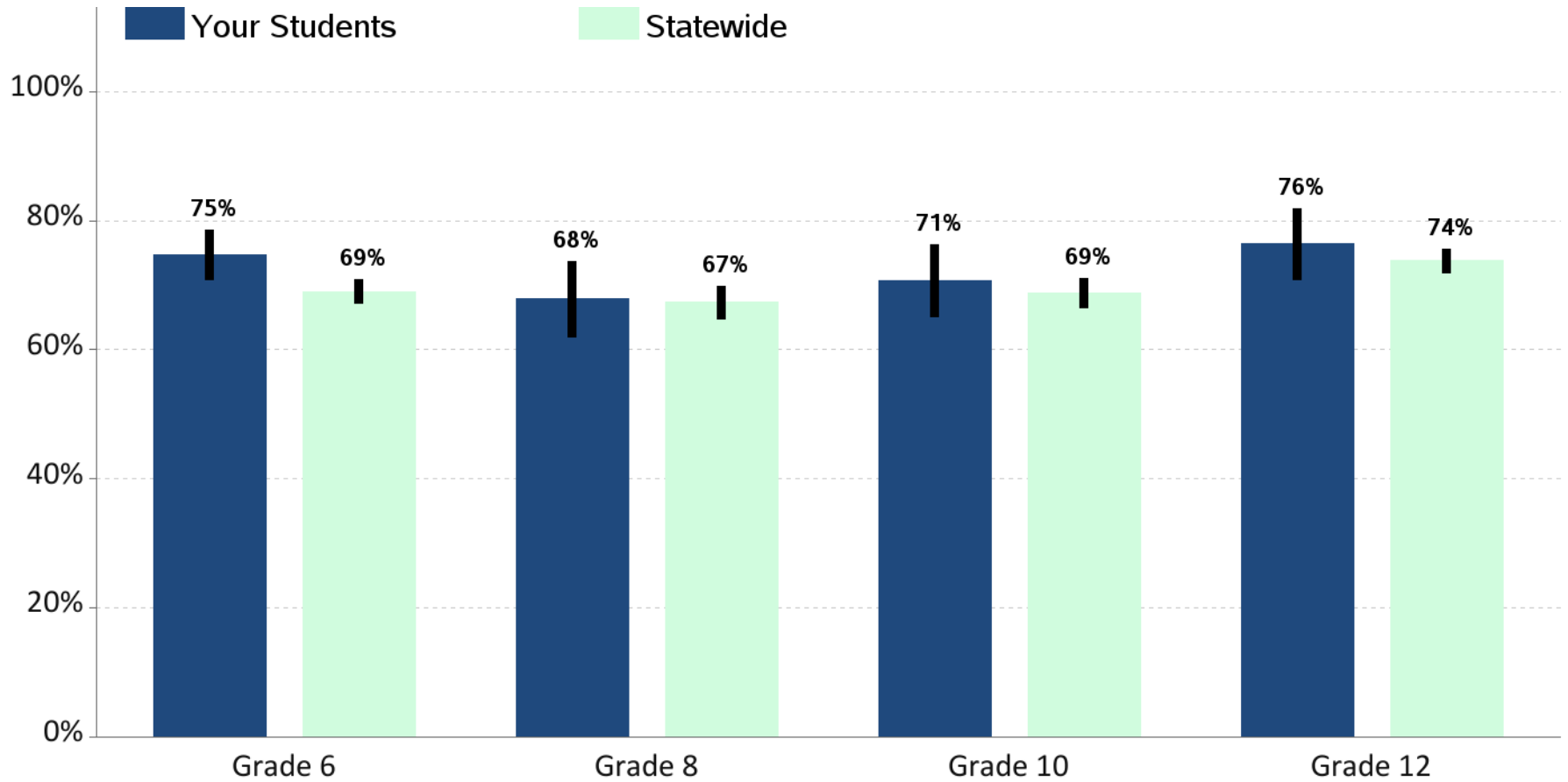
Opportunities for School Involvement
