Key Functions of the Board – 1005

Acting on behalf of the people of each community, the Board will fulfill the following functions:

Vision: The Board, with participation by the community, shall envision the future of the District's educational program and formulate goals, define outcomes and set the course for the District. This will be done within the context of racial, ethnic and religious diversity and with a commitment to education excellence and equity for all students.

Structure: To achieve the vision, the Board will establish a structure which reflects local circumstances and creates an environment designed to ensure all students the opportunity to attain their potential through a sound organizational framework. This includes employing a Superintendent, developing and approving policies, formulating budgets, setting high instructional and learning goals for staff and students, and nurturing a climate conducive to continuous improvement.

Accountability: The Board's accountability to the community will include adopting a system of continuous assessment of all conditions affecting education, including assessments for measuring staff and student progress towards goals. The public will be kept informed about programs and progress. Staff and Board training will be provided to ensure continuous improvement of student achievement.

Advocacy: The Board shall collectively strive to serve as advocates at the local, state and federal level on behalf of students and their schools. The Board shall work to advance the Board's vision for its schools, pursue the District's goals, encourage progress, energize systemic change and ensure that students are treated as citizens in a diversified society.
