Education of Students with Disabilities

Under Section 504 of the

Rehabilitation Act of 1973 -- 2162

It is the policy of the District to provide a free and appropriate public education to each student within its jurisdiction, including students with disabilities, regardless of the nature or severity of the disability.

It is the intent of the District to ensure that students who are disabled within the definition of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 are identified, evaluated, and provided with appropriate education services.
