Distribution of Materials - 3222

This policy applies to student expression and press freedoms not communicated by virtue of a school-sponsored or school-funded means of publication or communication. Publications or other communications authored by students may be distributed on school premises in accordance with procedures developed by the Superintendent. Such procedures may impose limits on the time, place, and manner of distribution, including prior authorization for the distribution or circulation of substantial quantities of printed material or the posting of such material on school property.

Students responsible for the distribution of material which leads to a substantial disruption of school activity, or otherwise interferes with school operations, shall be subject to corrective action or discipline, including suspension or expulsion or emergency expulsion, consistent with student discipline policies.
