### **Prevention and Management of Anaphylaxis – 3412**

The Superintendent or designee shall implement procedures for preventing anaphylaxis (life-threatening allergic reaction), for training school staff about anaphylaxis, for developing an Individualized Health Care Plan for a student who may experience anaphylaxis, and for communicating details of health care plans as appropriate in the school setting.

Parents/guardians are responsible for informing the school about a student's potential risk for anaphylaxis and for ensuring the provision of ongoing health information and necessary medical supplies. The district will take precautions to reduce the risk of anaphylaxis by developing strategies to minimize the presence of allergens in schools, but parents/guardians and school staff need to be aware that it is not possible to achieve a completely allergen-free environment.
