### **Communicable Disease – 3414**

The Superintendent shall implement procedures assuring that all school buildings are in compliance with State Board of Health rules and regulations regarding persons who have, or have been exposed to, a communicable disease. These procedures shall be consistent with the Infectious Disease Control Guide for School Staff compiled by the office of State Superintendent of Public Instruction and the Washington State Department of Health and the Communicable Disease Reporting and Resource Manual for School Nurses provided by the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department.
