Public Performances - 4235

The Board recognizes the scholastic and social values that may be derived from student participation in various activities sponsored by community organizations.

Subject to the approval of the building principal, students may perform at non-school activities as a representative of the district. Permission and approval to perform as a representative of the school or district shall be contingent upon the principal's determination that such participation is in the best interests of the student, school and district.

While students may perform in traditional musical events during holiday seasons, a school-sponsored group shall not perform or make such presentations during a worship service. Students with a fundamental personal or religious objection to participation in such performances shall be excused and offered an alternative educational experience. Such student shall suffer no grade or credit reduction for failure to participate in an objectionable performance.

The activity, program, performance or contest under consideration shall have educational value consistent with the goals and objectives of the district. Participation shall not result in exploitation of or liability to the student, school or district. Students shall not receive any remuneration for performing as representatives of the school or district.
