School Facility Use – 4260

District facilities have been developed primarily to further the education of the children of the Gig Harbor and Key Peninsulas. For purposes of this policy, the term “facilities” shall apply to all buildings and grounds. The Board realizes, however, that these facilities are suitable for other community group activities. They endorse such uses, provided such activities are not in conflict with the regular school program and provided that all arrangements are made in accordance with the provisions that follow.

District-sponsored activities, including curricular and co-curricular functions, retain first priority in the use of facilities.

Authorization for use of school facilities shall not be considered an endorsement or approval of an activity, group or organization.

Groups wishing to use District facilities for public activities must ensure that accommodations are available to allow individuals with disabilities to participate in the activity or program. Users must provide necessary accommodations for individuals with disabilities. Users may request consultation from the District in providing special accommodations to disabled persons. Disabled persons should contact the group leader no later than three (3) days before the activity so that special arrangements can be made.

The right to authorize use of school facilities shall be retained by the Board and/or the Superintendent through the appointed unit administrators consistent with this policy and such implementing regulations as the Superintendent may issue.
