Home School Community Partnership

Ad-hoc Advisory Groups- 4270

The Peninsula school Board will appoint, from time to time, home-school-community partnership task forces/committees and ask them to perform such duties as the Board deems appropriate. The ad hoc task forces/committees are advisory and will be designated to conduct studies in such areas, as the Board deems necessary.

The Board will establish procedures for the organization of these ad hoc committees in order that advisory groups may accomplish their mission and objectives.

The Board will consider all recommendations made to it by any ad hoc advisory task force/committee; however, the Board will reserve all subsequent decisions as a prerogative of the Board.

The use of the ad hoc task forces, steering and advisory committees by the Board does not preclude the right of other groups or individuals to present proposals, grievances, recommendations and suggestions at a Board meeting.

1. Board ad hoc advisory task forces and committees shall be recommended to the Board by the Superintendent and be given specific topics of responsibility and a definite time period with which to work. Such committees will automatically be dissolved upon the completion of the report or the end of the time period.
2. By agreeing to serve on the committee, a person indicated his/her willingness to comply with the Board's guidelines and developed for the committee.
3. The Board may appoint one of its members as a liaison with any Board committee.
4. All ad hoc advisory task forces and committees will have a chairperson approved by the Board president.
5. The ad hoc task force/committee chairperson will report all findings and recommendations to the Board through the Superintendent's office. Minority recommendations, as well as the majority recommendations, will be reviewed by the Board. Appearances of the task force/committee before the Board will be placed on the Board agenda by the Superintendent.

6. Each task force/committee will have an administrative officer of the District appointed by the Superintendent to serve in an ex officio advisory position to the committee.
7. An effort will be made to select members from each of the various constituencies of the district as appropriate to the ad hoc task force/committee mission.
8. Expenses of the committee may be allowed only if authorized in advance.
