Public Solicitation in Schools – 4280

The Peninsula Public Schools may participate in national charity drives -- such as the Junior Red Cross, the Goodwill Clothing Drive, the Washington Children's Home Bluebird Sale, and the March of Dimes. All national or local charities or like organizations desiring to enroll or obtain subscriptions from pupils must apply for permission from the Superintendent.

1. Collections thus approved shall be conducted so as to minimize the amount of school time required and to emphasize the educational and civic values of pupil participation
2. Any collection or drive, once approved, shall be subject to review annually by the office of the Superintendent
3. Contributions shall be made on a purely voluntary basis
4. Containers shall be provided and the collection conducted so others shall not know those amounts of contributions. Collections should never be made by pupils, nor should any record be kept of how much a pupil has given. No insignia shall be given which would identify a contributor from a non-contributor. No form of competition or any type of rewards or pressure shall be brought to bear upon pupils in any fund drive
