



Community Relations – Series 4000 Political Relationships with Governmental Agencies - 4300

School property and school time, supported by public funds, may not be used for political purposes.

District employees who hold elective or appointive office in an organization are not entitled to time off from their school duties for reasons incident to such offices except as such time may qualify under leave policies of the district.

The Superintendent is directed to establish implementing procedures that are in compliance with the Public Disclosure Commission.
