### **Employee Safety – 5205**

The Board recognizes that safety and health standards should be incorporated into all aspects of the operation of the District. Rules for safety and prevention of accidents shall be posted in compliance with OSHA and WISHA requirements. All hazardous chemicals will be identified and properly labeled. Employees shall be trained in the safe use of these chemicals specific to their respective jobs. Proper records will be maintained to verify that all necessary preventative and safety measures are in place. Injuries and accidents shall be reported to the District immediately.

The District shall have at least one employee at each school and work site who holds a valid certificate of first aid training. Each school and work site shall have first aid supplies readily accessible.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop necessary safety and health standards to comply with Department of Labor requirements.
