Waived and Reduced Admissions - 7270

It is the policy of the Peninsula School District to issue annually, upon request, to school directors and school administrators, passes for admission to school events. Directors and administrators receiving these passes will be expected to assist, when required, in the supervision of those attending or participating in the event.

School principals will issue a faculty supervisory card to faculty members valid for all regular school events in which their school participates and which are held at a Peninsula School District facility. School Principals may also issue single event passes to non-faculty supervisory personnel.

Reduced price admission will be available upon request to any purchaser who is 62 years of age or older.

Waived or reduced price admission will be available upon request to students and nonstudents who qualify using the USDA Child Nutrition Program guidelines. Each principal or designee shall notify parents/students of the process for obtaining an admission waiver or reduction.

Each of the above-described passes shall be issued to and used by only one individual. They shall not be used by anyone other than the individual named on the pass.
