### Physical examinations and immunizations may be obtained from the following:

- ❖ Your private health care provider
- ❖ *Well Child Clinic* at the office of Dean Shriner, ARNP  
(only for those families located south of the Purdy bridge)

Where: Key Center  
When: Every Tuesday morning, 9:00 – 10:00 AM  
How: First come, first served and no appointment is needed.  
Physical exams and immunizations provided for well children through the age of 12 years.

Cost: The total fee per child is **\$10.00**.

***NOTE: This clinic is only for children without medical insurance or medical coupons; cash or check only.***

Immunizations required for school attendance include the following:

***IPV*** (Polio), ***DTaP*** (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis), ***Tdap*** (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis), ***HEP B*** (Hepatitis B), ***MMR*** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), and ***VARICELLA*** (Chickenpox).

For preschool only: ***Hib*** (Hemophilus Influenza B) and ***PCV*** (Pneumococcal conjugate)

Other immunizations that are **recommended** but are not required for school attendance include: *Hepatitis A, Meningococcal, Influenza, HPV (Human papillomavirus), and Rotavirus (for infants only).*

Immunizations are provided for children through the age of 18 years.

***Remember to bring your child's immunization record with you to the clinic.***
